<b>Project Description</b>	<p>The Phenol factory in the Lukavac industrial zone started operating in 1953, and it was closed due to the war in 1992. Since then, no maintenance work has been carried out and the surroundings have never been remediated. Due to heavy industry (production of coke, cement, etc.), the mentioned area is a source of pollution for the entire area of Lukavac. As part of the project, research was carried out to provide risk assessments for the environment and human health. This was the base for the technical plan by which the remediation of the polluted industrial area was carried out. With the aim to minimize additional pollution, modern approach and technology was used. The remediated area will be covered with rehabilitated soil. The level of pollution of water resources and soils will be significantly reduced, which will mitigate the risk to human health in the area of the Lukavac industrial zone and beyond.</p>
