Project Description	<p>In 2016, the European Union adopted the Web Accessibility Directive for public sector websites and mobile applications, obliging member states to ensure digital accessibility for all, especially for people with disabilities and the elderly. Approximately 27% of the EU population faces some form of disability. The aim of the project is to improve web accessibility in Bosnia and Herzegovina, particularly for the elderly and individuals with various disabilities. By enhancing digital inclusion for the most disadvantaged groups, the project contributes to reducing inequalities and opens up greater opportunities for these groups to access education, employment, and essential online services that are crucial for social and economic empowerment.</p> <p>The project plans to establish an online platform and digital database, as well as to develop a three-tier methodology for assessing web accessibility. Additionally, an international expert roundtable will be held, and a manual on web accessibility in BiH will be published. Training sessions are also planned to equip stakeholders with the necessary knowledge to improve web accessibility.</p>
