| Project Description | <p>The project addresses the consequences of the Russian military aggression against Ukraine, which has led to an increase in the number of socially deprived children, especially orphans and children without parental care. In the framework of a charity campaign organised by the media house Pro Plus, funds were raised to improve the conditions of those children and handed over to the Ljubljana Moste-Polje Association of Friends of Youth. The aim of the project is to provide a foster family with 8-10 children with a comfortable, safe and energy-efficient home of approximately 300 m². The house will be equipped with energy efficient heating, lighting and insulation systems, which will reduce the consumption of non-renewable energy sources and CO₂ emissions. The project will improve the living conditions of the children, provide access to education and social services, and contribute to their integration into society, while supporting key sustainable development objectives.</p> |
