Project Description	<p>In the Municipality of Fojnica, which was severely affected by the floods in October 2024, key interventions are planned to remedy the consequences and improve the living conditions of the local population.</p> <p>In the village of Trošnjik, the riverbed of the Željeznica River was regulated and reinforced after it overflowed during floods, damaging the left bank and threatening the R437 Fojnica-Ostrožac regional road. The planned regulation of the riverbed will prevent further erosion, increase the safety of the residents of the settlement and improve traffic safety on the regional road.</p> <p>In the village of Luke (MZ Gojevići), the local road was repaired and asphalted, which had temporarily restricted traffic access to the village due to flooding. The road renovation will restore safe and reliable access and improve the connectivity of the local community.</p> <p>In MZ Bakovići, the local road Bakovići – Poljana to the drinking water reservoir was renovated, as it had been damaged by heavy rainfall and was threatening the stable supply of drinking water. The renovation will ensure a safe, stable, and high-quality supply of drinking water to residents and reduce their vulnerability to potential future disasters.</p> <p>The project was implemented by CMSR in cooperation with Caritas Slovenia and was co-financed by the Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs of the Republic of Slovenia.</p>
