Project Description	The existing water supply network in the village of Novostavtsi, extending over 16.5 kilometres, was built in 1983 and has not undergone comprehensive reconstruction since then. Due to the deterioration of the pipes, frequent breakdowns, pressure drops, leaks and water contamination occur, endangering public health and worsening sanitary conditions. The three existing artesian wells are depleted and can no longer provide sufficient quantities of water, while the system is economically and environmentally unsustainable due to energy-inefficient pumps and high water losses. The project will enable the comprehensive reconstruction and modernisation of the water supply system. Project and investment documentation will be prepared, a new artesian well will be constructed and one existing well will be rehabilitated. A total of 16.5 kilometres of deteriorated water supply pipes will be replaced with modern polymer pipes, energy-efficient pumping equipment will be installed, and a remote system for monitoring water flow and pressure will be established. The project also includes training for local staff, a public information campaign and surveys of residents' satisfaction with water quality. The project will provide residents with a safer, more reliable and more energy-efficient supply of drinking water, while contributing to the protection of public health, improved living conditions and the sustainable use of water and energy resources.
