# **DECISION**

## **on the appointment of an authorized person for the implementation of the CMSR Code of Conduct**

Mag. Darja Žlogar, employed in the position of Head of the Department of Economic Research, is hereby appointed to monitor the implementation of the CMSR Code of Conduct.

The responsibilities of the authorized person include:

- monitoring the implementation of the Code of Conduct and reporting annually to the CMSR management;
- interpreting the Code of Conduct for stakeholders as defined therein;
- receiving reports of violations of the Code of Conduct, examining them, informing CMSR management of anonymized reports, and ensuring appropriate protection of the whistleblower in accordance with the guidelines of the Commission for the Prevention of Corruption;
- conducting appropriate procedures depending on the nature of the violation.

The appointed person is also authorized, for the purposes of implementing the Code of Conduct, to directly contact the Commission for the Prevention of Corruption if necessary, or to procure legal services from an external law firm of her choosing, at the expense of CMSR, without requiring prior approval from the Director.

In performing her duties under this Decision, the authorized person shall ensure compliance with the law, protect business secrets, and act with the diligence of a prudent businessperson.
